

ABBACOL INTERNACIONAL HUMANITARIAN PROGRAMME



DESCRIPTION:

The AbbaCol humanitarian programme focuses on offering students over the age of +18 the opportunity to visit Colombia and have the experience of immersing themselves in the humanitarian field, logistical support and being in contact with vulnerable communities.

DURATION OF THE PROGRAMME:

3 weeks

Dates: To be notified to the selected candidates

INVESTMENT:

The programme for students costs 3,000USD

It includes:

- Accommodation at the two humanitarian intervention sites in Bogota and Sutatausa.
- Food and transport at the national level.

PLACES TO BE VISITED:

- Bogota DC - All students will arrive in the city of Bogota, stay 3-4 days, there will be an induction and visit some tourist sites in the city.
- Sutatausa - In the municipality of Sutatausa students will have the opportunity to meet the communities that AbbaCol works with, experience the culture and develop humanitarian work in the area.

HUMANITARIAN DIPLOMA:

At the end of the humanitarian programme each student will receive a diploma with the hours completed of the social work in the field.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Each participant has to covered the airfare from the place of origin and return.
- Each participant will need an international medical insurance (This will have to be sent to info@abbacol.org).
